## **Amendments to Mandatory Requirements Recently Agreed at the International Maritime Organization (IMO)**

### **Summary**

- This Marine Information Note (MIN) explains how to obtain the latest information on decisions taken at the IMO that impact on internationally agreed mandatory regulations and codes.

### **1. Introduction/ Background**

- 1.1 The number of amendments to IMO Mandatory Instruments agreed at IMO and the size of the documentation involved mean that it is not practicable to publish the information in a MIN to all interested parties.
- 1.2 To keep our customers informed of the very latest information available a table of agreed amendments to IMO Mandatory Instruments is held on the Maritime and Coastguard Agency (MCA) website.
