Summary

The purpose of this Unified Interpretation is to provide guidance to operators looking to use biofuels or biofuels blends on complying with their regulatory obligations, in particular under MARPOL Annex VI Regulation 18.


1. Introduction/Background

- 1.1 The Red Ensign Group (REG) is receiving an increasing number of enquiries from ship owners and their Recognised Organisations who are wishing to undertake trials using biofuels and biofuel blends as an alternative fuel as a means of reducing the net carbon emissions from their vessels.
- 1.2 Currently Regulation 18.3.2 in MARPOL Annex VI has specific requirements for 'fuel oil for combustion purposes derived by methods other than petroleum refining'. Additionally, Interpretation 15 of MEPC.1/Circ.795/Rev.9 as amended provides further information on the applicability of Regulation 18.3 for biofuel and synthetic fuel. This UI is to provide the REG position on the application of the guidance in interpretation 15 of MEPC.1/Circ.795/Rev.9 as amended.
